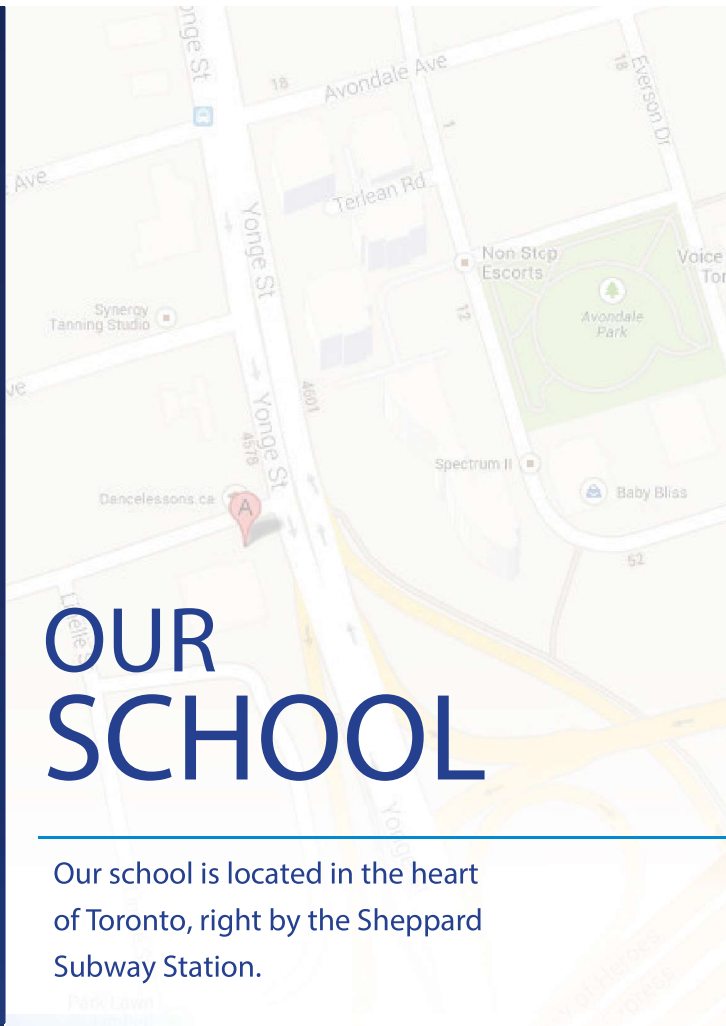

IELTS

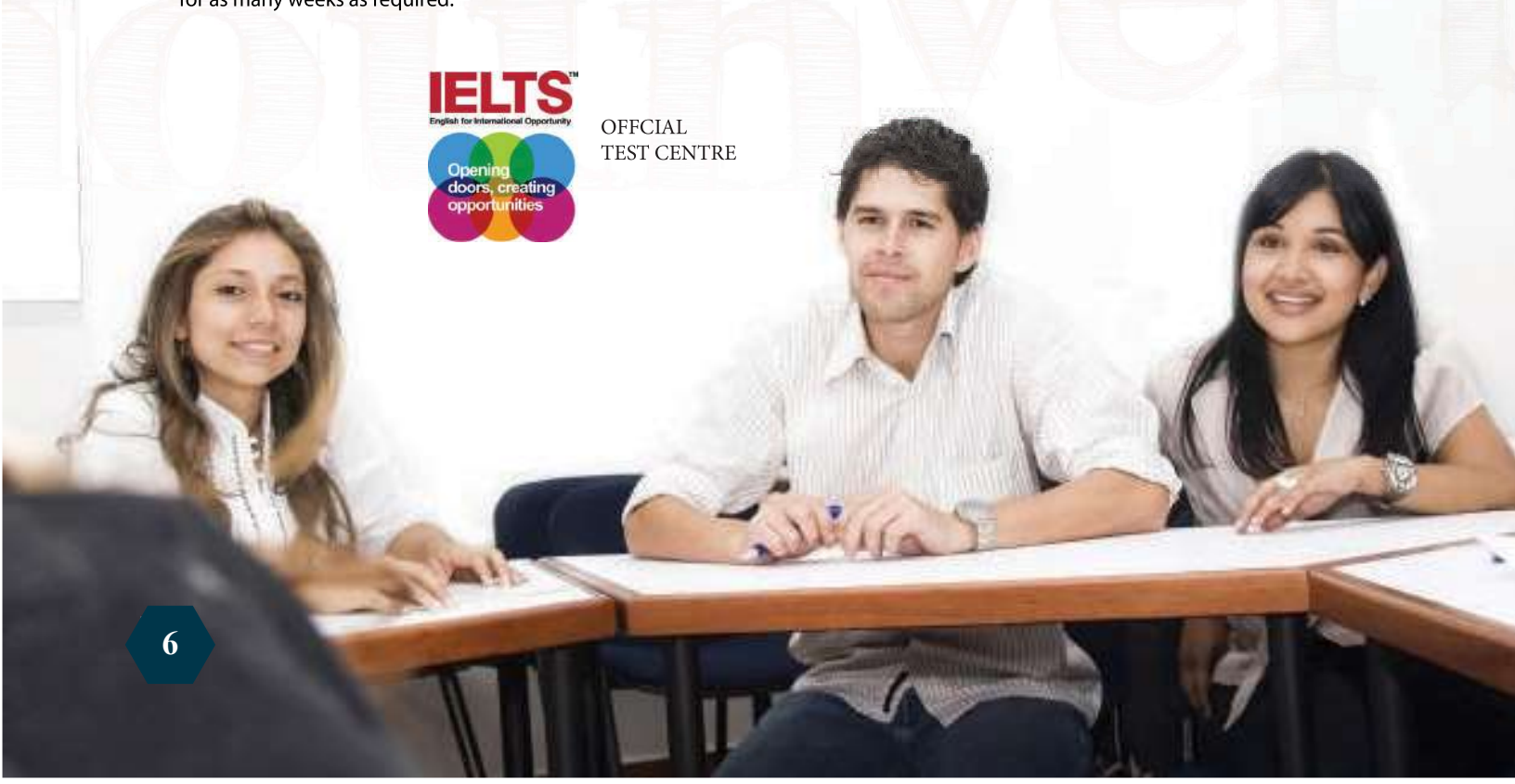

International student admission



Complete the following steps for getting admission to Duke:

1. Complete the Duke application.
2. Submit an official transcript from your previous school
3. Pay the application fee.
4. Two copies of the biographical page of your passport.
5. Two passport-size photos.
6. Visa application form.

Important Dates and Information

- All students should submit all the documents for admission 30 days before the start of classes.
- All students must pay tuition fees before the deadline.
- All students are required to pay a \$250 non-refundable course registration deposit which will be applied toward the tuition fee. Course registration fees are non-refundable if a student should withdraw from a course.

Registration Process

Once students are admitted, the office of Admission will send them an official acceptance email and a formal letter in the mail. New students can schedule either in-person or telephone appointments for registration. For the ESL classes, students must see the counselor to assess their class level. Transfer students will be advised appropriately based on the courses taken at other institutions.
